

Philippine Embassy Witnesses the Official Opening of MV LOGOS Hope



The Philippine Embassy, led by Third Secretary and Vice Consul Angeli A. Payumo, attended the official opening of MV LOGOS Hope International Bookfair in Aqaba, Jordan on January 26, 2023, as part of the ship's regional tour, following Lebanon and Egypt.

Her Royal Highness Princess Rym Al-Ali of the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan graced the occasion as the Guest of Honor, along with other local dignitaries, and press members. The opening ceremony featured the history and advocacies of the MV Logos Hope, as well as its diverse international crew of volunteers from over 65 countries.
