NOTICE IS HEREBY ANNOUNCED that the Philippine Embassy in Jordan is inviting qualified individuals to submit their application for the services of a **Receptionist**, **Translator/Interpreter and Telephone Operator** for a period of six (6) months, subject for renewal on the basis of performance.

For an applicant to be considered for the position, they must:

- · Possess at least a relevant Bachelor's Degree;
- · Have 3-5 years of related professional experience;
- · Be fluent in English and Arabic, Filipino is a huge advantage;
- · Be medically fit to work;
- Be knowledgeable on computer applications: Microsoft Word, Excel, PowerPoint, and Google Workspace.

An applicant must also:

- · Be of good standing as a citizen of the Kingdom;
- · Have the ability to work well with others and handle multiple roles;
- Be able to respond quickly and correctly in case of emergency situations concerning distressed overseas Filipino workers; and
- Be ready to perform other duties that may be required in the exigency of the service.

The successful candidate shall be expected to perform the following tasks:

- Translate documents and other materials from English to Arabic and vice versa;
- Translate spoken languages from English to Arabic and vice versa during seminars, meetings and other Embassy transactions;
- Answer and forward phone calls to appropriate sections in the Embassy;
- · Provide appropriate assistance to Embassy clients and visitors; and
- Assist with other duties that may be assigned in the exigency of the service.

The successful candidate will be working from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm (inclusive of a one-hour lunch break) from Sunday to Thursday. Occasional overtime services may be required.

The position offers a competitive salary commensurate with relevant experience and other benefits.
